Frequently Asked Questions





1. When is the Goodyear Blimp hangar drive-through toy drop off?

The Blimp hangar drive-through drop off events will take place on December 11, 12 and 13 from 1 to 8 pm.

2. Where is the Goodyear Blimp hangar?

The Goodyear Blimp hangar is located at 841 Wingfoot Lake Road, Mogadore, OH 44260. Upon arriving, please remain in your vehicle and follow all posted signage to proceed through the toy drop-off route.

3. What is the process for the toy drop-off?

Before leaving home, please place the toys you wish to donate in the trunk of your vehicle. Once arriving at the hangar, please join the line of vehicles and follow posted signage to proceed around and into the hangar. Remain in your vehicle with the windows fully rolled up throughout the process. If using a motorcycle or vehicle with no roof / windows, a mask must be worn fully covering your nose and mouth throughout the process. Once at the toy drop-off point, please release the latch on the trunk from inside your vehicle if necessary and allow volunteers to retrieve the toys from your trunk. This process is to maintain safe social/physical distancing and minimize the risk of COVID-19 spread. After retrieving the toys, volunteers will close the trunk on your vehicle and direct you to proceed along the route out of the hangar.

4. What ages are supported by Toys for Tots?

Most campaign sites are able to assist children up to age 12, but in many local communities, local support is such that the age limit may be extended.

5. Is there a list of toys available to guide me with my donation?

Toys for Tots does not publish a list of appropriate toys to donate. If such a list were created, most would follow it, resulting in a limited selection of items to distribute in each community. We would rather our donors consider what might be an appropriate gift for their own child/relative, purchase the item, and donate to Toys for Tots.

6. Are there toys/gifts that are **not** accepted/distributed?

Toys for Tots prefers not to accept realistic looking toy weapons and gifts with food. If donated, such items will NOT be distributed.

7. Pre-teen/teens are groups for which shopping is especially difficult. Do you have any ideas?

The Foundation does purchase supplemental toys/gifts for our campaign sites and focuses on these age groups. In the past, items purchased for these groups have included, but are not limited to: sporting equipment/bags/balls; books, backpacks, cosmetics, purses,

watch/wallet gift sets, bath gift sets, board games, radio control cars/trucks, hand-held electronics, skateboards/helmets, curling irons, hair straighteners, and hair dryers.

8. How can I obtain toys for my children or for someone else?
